



FALL 2020 STUDENT EMPLOYMENT FAQ

Q: Can students work after 11/25?

A: Yes, as long as working past this date has been approved through the SWAN system.

Q: If a student is approved to work the week of 11/25 – 12/3, are they required to work remotely?

A: No.

Q: If a student is approved to work the week of 11/25 – 12/3, can they work 29 hours that week?

A: No.

Q: Are GA's required to work remotely from 11/25 – 12/3?

A: No.

Q: Can students/GAs work remotely all semester?

A: Yes, in accordance with the [Teleworking \(interim\) policy 8.3.8](#)

Q: Can students/GAs work on campus if their supervisor is working from home?

A: Students may not work on campus without supervision from ECU faculty or staff.

Q: Are there any on-campus living requirements for students/GA'S who are working on campus?

A: No. As long as they have sufficient transportation to and from work, they can live on or off campus.

Q: Are student employees allowed to work a flexible schedule during the fall semester if they are taking online courses?

A: Yes. However, if the student is enrolled in a hybrid course or an online course that has a set classroom time listed, the instructor must email April Harris (april.harris@eku.edu) in the Financial Aid office confirming the days and time the class is online before the student begins working.
